**Amendment to Amendment (916229)**

Between lines 181 and 182 of the amendment, insert:

Section 10. (1) For fiscal year 2017-2018, the sum of \$3,342,525 in nonrecurring funds is appropriated from the Federal Grants Trust Fund to the Department of Children and Families to contract with a vendor to develop an asset verification service for food assistance programs pursuant to s. 414.393, Florida Statutes, as created by this act, and the sum of \$300,000 in nonrecurring funds is appropriated from the Federal Grants Trust Fund to the Department of Children and

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13 Families to perform the technology modifications necessary to  
14 implement the asset verification service.

15 (2) This section shall take effect July 1, 2017, if  
16 CS/CS/CS/HB 581 or similar legislation relating to an asset  
17 verification service for food assistance programs is not adopted  
18 during the same legislative session or an extension thereof and  
19 fails to become a law.

20 Section 11. (1) For fiscal year 2017-2018, the sum of  
21 \$500,000 in nonrecurring funds is appropriated from the Welfare  
22 Transition Trust Fund to the Department of Economic Opportunity  
23 for distribution to CareerSource Florida, Inc., to contract for  
24 development of a program to serve temporary cash assistance work  
25 registrants with significant barriers to employment pursuant to  
26 this act, including, but not limited to, providing the initial  
27 program design, evaluation design, training curricula  
28 development and delivery of training, implementation oversight,  
29 development of informational materials for participants, and  
30 technical assistance; and for distribution to selected local  
31 workforce boards for startup expenses incurred by vendors  
32 implementing the program, including, but not limited to,  
33 information technology updates, program coordination, and staff  
34 training. Case management and direct services for all temporary  
35 cash assistance recipients shall be provided within current  
36 resources.

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37        (2) This section shall take effect July 1, 2017, if  
38        CS/CS/CS/HB 581 or similar legislation relating to public  
39        assistance programs is not adopted during the same legislative  
40        session or an extension thereof and fails to become a law.

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
