The clerk of the court shall implement a monitoring 27 and quality control plan to ensure that all judicial 28 determinations of paternity are reported to the department in 29 compliance with this section. The department shall track 30 paternity determinations reported monthly by county, monitor 31 compliance with the 30-day timeframe, and report the data to the 32 clerks of the court quarterly.

(5) NONCERTIFIED COPY OF ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE.-

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an adoptee 34 (a) 35 who is at least 18 years of age, or if the adoptee is deceased, the adoptee's descendants, or the legal representative of such 36 37 an adoptee may apply to the department for a noncertified copy 38 of the adoptee's original birth certificate. The department 39 shall issue a noncertified copy of original birth certificate, 40 together with the documents forwarded to the department pursuant 41 subsection (1), within 45 days after receipt of the application, 42 if the application complies with the requirements of this 43 subsection. 44 The department shall develop policies and procedures (b) 45 necessary to implement this subsection by February 1, 2018. 46 (c) The department may charge a fee for issuing a 47 noncertified copy of original birth certificate. The fee may not 48 exceed the fee for a certified copy of an original birth 49 certificate under s. 382.0255.
