309 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity to expand the exemption from public records 310 311 requirements that applies to the home addresses, telephone 312 numbers, dates of birth, and photographs of firefighters 313 certified under s. 633.408; the home addresses, telephone 314 numbers, photographs, dates of birth, and places of employment of the spouses and children of such firefighters; and the names 315 316 and locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the 317 children of such firefighters to include former firefighters and 318 their spouses and children. The personal identifying and 319 location information of other former first responders, such as 320 former law enforcement officers, and their family members is 321 currently exempt from public records requirements. Firefighters 322 often respond to serious emergency situations ranging from domestic violence to homicide, and the release of personal 323 324 identifying and location information may place former 325 firefighters and their family members in danger of serious

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326	physical or emotional harm by hostile individuals. The		
327	Legislature further finds that the harm that may result from the		
328	release of such identifying and location information outweighs		
329	any public benefit that may be derived from the disclosure of		
330	such information.
