guardian; patients who are eligible to receive marijuana for medical use in their state of permanent residence and hold a valid patient identification card or its equivalent; and caregivers registered pursuant to subsection (6).

- 1. Before issuing an identification card to a patient, the department must determine that:
 - a. The patient is a permanent resident of the state or, for

a patient under the age of 18, the patient's parent or legal quardian is a permanent resident of the state. The patient, or the parent or legal guardian of the patient, must prove permanent residency by providing the department with a copy of a valid Florida driver license or Florida identification card, a copy of a utility bill in his or her name issued within the prior 90 days which shows an address in this state, or a copy of his or her Florida voter information card.

- b. If the patient is not a permanent resident of the state and he or she is eliqible to receive marijuana in his or her state of permanent residence:
- (I) The patient, or the parent or legal guardian of the patient holds a valid patient identification card or its equivalent issued within his or her state of permanent residence to the department; or
- (II) The patient has been issued a physician certification that meets the requirements of subsection (3), and he or she will be remaining in this state for at least
