- 2. A vacation rental owner, or his or her representative, shall submit to the local jurisdiction a copy of the vacation rental license required under chapter 509, a copy of the certificate of registration required under s. 212.18, and emergency contact information. The submission of such documents and information is for informational purposes only. The local jurisdiction may not assess a fee for the submission.
- 3. This paragraph does not apply to any local law, ordinance, or regulation adopted on or before June 1, 2011, including any amendment to such law, ordinance, or regulation that is less restrictive or that reduces the local regulatory burden on vacation rentals owned, in whole or part, by a person who is currently serving on active duty or temporary duty in a branch of the United States Armed Services or owned by a disabled veteran with a service-connected evaluation of such disability of 30 percent or more, according to the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to vacation rentals; amending s. 509.032, F.S.; authorizing local laws, ordinances, or regulations to regulate activities relating to vacation rentals only if such laws, ordinances, or regulations apply uniformly to all properties; requiring a vacation rental owner, or his or her representative, to submit specified documents and information to the local jurisdiction; prohibiting the local jurisdiction from charging certain fees; revising applicability for preemption of certain local laws, ordinances, or regulations regarding vacation rentals; providing an effective date.

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
