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An act relating to public utilities; amending s. 366.02, F.S.; exempting certain producers of renewable solar-based energy from being defined as a public utility; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 366.02, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

366.02 Definitions.—As used in this chapter:

(1) "Public utility" means every person, corporation, partnership, association, or other legal entity and their lessees, trustees, or receivers supplying electricity or gas (natural, manufactured, or similar gaseous substance) to or for the public within this state; but the term "public utility" does not include either a cooperative now or hereafter organized and existing under the Rural Electric Cooperative Law of the state; a municipality or any agency thereof; an entity that produces and provides or sells energy to users located on the property of a renewable energy production facility that uses a solar-based source of renewable energy as defined in s. 377.803(4), provided that such facility has a capacity of 2.5 megawatts or less; any dependent or independent special natural gas district; any natural gas transmission pipeline company making only sales or transportation delivery of natural gas at wholesale and to direct industrial consumers; any entity selling or arranging for sales of natural gas which neither owns nor operates natural gas transmission or distribution facilities within the state; or a person supplying liquefied petroleum gas, in either liquid or gaseous form, irrespective of the method of distribution or delivery, or owning or operating facilities beyond the outlet of

37-00253A-17 2017456 a meter through which natural gas is supplied for compression 33 and delivery into motor vehicle fuel tanks or other 34 transportation containers, unless such person also supplies 35 36 electricity or manufactured or natural gas. 37 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
