(1) (a) The Department of Transportation shall adopt a uniform system of specific, high-visibility pavement markings and signage for use on arterial roads or collector roads, as defined in s. 334.03, within a 1-mile radius of all schools, public and private, to designate safe school crossing locations. In adopting the uniform system, the department may consider implementation of new technology or innovations that enhance pedestrian and crosswalk visibility.

- (b) The Department of Transportation shall compile, publish, and transmit a manual containing all specifications and requirements with respect to the system of markings and signage established pursuant to paragraph (a) to the governing body of each county and municipality in the state. The Department of Transportation and each county and municipality in the state shall install and maintain such markings and signage in conformity with such uniform system.
- (2) Upon request from the appropriate local governmental entity, the Department of Transportation shall install and maintain such safe school crossing markings and signage on arterial or collector roads as prescribed in this section for all schools, public and private, within the jurisdiction of the local governmental entity.
- (3) (a) A safe school crossing located on a statemaintained arterial or collector road shall be maintained by the Department of Transportation. However, this section does not

prohibit the Department of Transportation from entering into agreements with counties or municipalities whereby the local governmental entities would maintain specified safe school crossings located on state-maintained arterial or collector roads.

- (b) The county shall maintain a safe school crossing located outside any municipality and on a county road.
- (c) A municipality shall maintain a safe school crossing located in the municipality.
- (d) For the purposes of this section, the term
  "maintained," with respect to any safe school crossing location,
  means the care and maintenance of all safe school crossing
  markings and signage.
- (4) (a) A safe school crossing location maintained by a county shall be periodically inspected by the county sheriff's office or any other qualified agent to determine whether the safe school crossing location is being properly maintained.
- (b) A safe school crossing location maintained by a municipality shall be periodically inspected by the municipal police department or any other qualified agent to determine whether the safe school crossing location is being properly maintained.
- (5) The Department of Transportation shall establish adequate standards for permanent and portable signs used for the designation of safe school crossing locations.
