An act relating to income inequality impact statements; creating s. 11.52, F.S.; requiring the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability to prepare an income inequality impact statement for proposed legislation upon the request of a member of the Legislature; specifying requirements for the impact statement; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 11.52, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

11.52 Income inequality impact statement.—At the request of a member of the Legislature, the Office of Program Policy

Analysis and Government Accountability shall prepare an impact statement that estimates the anticipated effects of proposed legislation on income inequality among the residents of this state. The impact statement must indicate if the proposed legislation would increase, decrease, or have no impact on income inequality or if the impact is indeterminable. To the extent feasible, the impact statement should include quantifiable data. The impact statement must specify the methodologies and assumptions used in its preparation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
