Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Florida Domestic Animal Recovery Act."

Section 2. Section 768.1392, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

768.1392 Liability for compensatory damages for injury or death of domestic animals.—

- (1) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "Damages" has the same applicability as provided in s. 768.71(1).
- (b) "Domestic animal" means any equine or bovine animal, goat, sheep, swine, domestic cat, dog, poultry, ostrich, emu, rhea, or other domesticated beast or bird.
- (c) "Noneconomic damages" means nonmonetary losses, including, but not limited to, inconvenience, pain and suffering, or mental or emotional pain or anguish, or loss of sentimental value, love and affection, comfort, companionship, or enjoyment.
- (2) In any action for the recovery of damages arising out of the injury or death of a domestic animal, the defendant:
- (a) Is subject to liability for objectively verifiable monetary losses for reasonable and necessary veterinary care of the domestic animal due to the injury or death of the animal.
 - (b) Is subject to liability for objectively verifiable
