 2           An act relating to the state group insurance program;  
 3           amending s. 110.123, F.S.; establishing a state  
 4           employee health and wellness clinic program; providing  
 5           conditions for the Division of State Group Insurance  
 6           to select a vendor to manage the program; specifying  
 7           services to be provided by the program; providing for  
 8           locations and hours of operation of program clinics;  
 9           providing for duration of the program; requiring the  
 10          Department of Management Services to submit an annual  
 11          report to the Governor and Legislature; providing an  
 12          effective date.

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 14   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 16           Section 1. Subsection (14) is added to section 110.123,  
 17   Florida Statutes, to read:

18           110.123 State group insurance program.—

19           (14) STATE EMPLOYEE HEALTH AND WELLNESS CLINIC PROGRAM.—

20           (a) The Division of State Group Insurance shall establish  
 21   a state employee health and wellness clinic program.

22           (b) The division shall select a vendor procured by  
 23   competitive solicitation pursuant to chapter 287 that shall  
 24   establish and manage two health and wellness clinics to provide

25 members of the state group health insurance program with access  
26 to the following services:

27 1. Primary care services, including walk-in, consultative,  
28 and urgent care services.

29 2. Medication dispensing.

30 3. Wellness services, including online tools and services,  
31 health risk assessments and recommendations, health and wellness  
32 information mailings, health fairs, wellness screenings, and on-  
33 site education.

34 4. Occupational health services, including return-to-work  
35 planning, new hire and emergent drug screening, and injury care.

36 5. Administration of vaccines and immunizations, including  
37 influenza virus immunizations.

38 6. Access to and management of electronic medical records.

39 (c) The vendor is not required to file insurance claims,  
40 including medical, health, and workers' compensation claims, for  
41 any service provided by the clinics.

42 (d) At least one program clinic shall provide laboratory  
43 services and may offer optional digital radiology services and  
44 prenatal support services for pregnant employees.

45 (e) The program shall begin no later than January 1, 2018.

46 One clinic shall be established at the Southwood Complex and  
47 shall operate for no more than 40 hours per week. The other  
48 clinic shall be established in Miami-Dade County and shall  
49 operate for no less than 40 hours per week. The hours of

50 operation for the two clinics shall be mutually exclusive. The  
51 location of the clinics shall be on property owned by the state  
52 and shall be provided at no cost to the vendor.

53 (f) The term of the division's contract with the program  
54 vendor shall be for no more than 5 years. By February 1, 2018,  
55 and by February 1 of each of the remaining 4 years that the  
56 program is in effect, the department shall submit a report to  
57 the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of  
58 the House of Representatives that evaluates the extent to which  
59 the vendor has:

60 1. Implemented comprehensive health and wellness services  
61 for state employees.

62 2. Leveraged group purchasing power to provide  
63 comprehensive health and wellness services.

64 3. Distributed health and wellness information and health  
65 education materials.

66 4. Maintained consistent standards for quality of care.

67 5. Achieved cost savings as a result of state employees'  
68 use of clinic services.

69 6. Achieved and guaranteed employee engagement and  
70 satisfaction.

71 7. Achieved a positive return on investment with the  
72 vendor having no more than 10 percent of the contract at risk.

73 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
