11	WHEREAS, the groundwater supply is vital to the state's
12	economy, and approximately 93 percent of Florida residents rely
13	on it for their drinking water, and
14	WHEREAS, Florida's springs reflect groundwater conditions
15	and provide an important habitat for wildlife, making them a
16	natural resource that must be protected, and
17	WHEREAS, springs provide important recreational resources
18	and opportunities that are enjoyed by citizens and visitors of
19	this state alike, and
20	WHEREAS, Florida's springs discharge nearly 8 billion
21	gallons of water each day, and healthy springs reflect the State
22	of Florida's commitment to sustainable groundwater and surface
23	water resource protection, NOW, THEREFORE,
