6	WHEREAS, in May 1991, then-Governor Lawton Chiles signed
7	into law a bill passed by the Florida Legislature authorizing
8	the creation of Florida's tenth public university, Florida Gulf
9	Coast University (FGCU), to provide higher education
10	opportunities and workforce development in the previously
11	underserved region of Southwest Florida, and
12	WHEREAS, FGCU opened its doors to students on August 25,
13	1997, and held its first commencement in May 1998 with 81
14	graduates, and
15	WHEREAS, in August 2017, FGCU will celebrate its 20th
16	anniversary, and
17	WHEREAS, during FGCU's first 20 years, it has been led by
18	three outstanding and dynamic presidents: President Roy
19	McTarnaghan, President William C. Merwin, and President Wilson
20	G. Bradshaw, and
21	WHEREAS, FGCU has strategically grown into a regional
22	university of nearly 15,000 students and today offers 55
23	undergraduate, 30 graduate, 11 certificate, and 3 doctoral
24	programs, and
25	WHEREAS, FGCU's top priority is student success, with five

26 colleges providing relevant programs with an accomplished 27 faculty, small classes, and extensive individualized attention 28 to help students prepare for successful careers and meet 29 regional and statewide workforce needs, and

30 WHEREAS, FGCU has achieved national prominence in 31 academics, environmental sustainability, and student service 32 learning, with over two million hours contributed to the 33 Southwest Florida community since 1997, and

34 WHEREAS, FGCU started with land and a grand plan consisting 35 of 400 acres of restored and preserved wetlands, and

36 WHEREAS, FGCU operates a 15-acre solar field that generates 37 85 percent of the electric power for three academic buildings, 38 saving \$700,000 in energy costs annually, and

39 WHEREAS, FGCU emphasizes innovative and interdisciplinary 40 learning, using the region as a living laboratory while offering 41 students diverse opportunities to participate in meaningful 42 research led by their professors, who have conducted more than 43 \$204.8 million in research and sponsored programs since 1997, 44 and

WHEREAS, FGCU has established the Institute of Entrepreneurship, bringing engineering and business students together to develop products and business plans in a real-world setting, and the Emergent Technologies Institute to provide learning opportunities that will enhance the university's science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM)

51 education and sustainability initiatives, and

52 WHEREAS, FGCU has one of only 19 PGA-certified golf 53 management programs in the country and the only certified 54 program in Florida accepting enrollment of new students, and

55 WHEREAS, FGCU is a leader in the State University System of 56 this state, with approximately 75 percent of alumni employed or 57 continuing their education within one year after graduation, and

58 WHEREAS, FGCU focuses on college affordability for all 59 students by maintaining its commitment to cost containment, 60 holding tuition at the same level for four years, and

61 WHEREAS, FGCU serves as a cultural hub for the region, 62 offering a wealth of enrichment opportunities that include the 63 visual arts, music, theater, and public radio and television, 64 and

65 WHEREAS, FGCU's athletics programs continue to be a growing 66 source of pride for their loyal fans, earning 56 league titles 67 in the past 9 years and making 25 NCAA Tournament appearances in 68 the previous five seasons, and

69 WHEREAS, FGCU has had a total of 9 student athletes who70 have advanced to professional teams, and

71 WHEREAS, FGCU experienced international exposure at the 72 2016 Summer Olympic Games held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, with 73 beach volleyball player, Brooke Youngquist Sweat, 2008 alumna, 74 representing the United States, joining two FGCU alumnae 75 swimmers, Lani Cabrera, 2016 alumna, and Evita Leter, 2017

77	WHEREAS, FGCU student athletes continue to demonstrate
78	their academic strengths by earning an overall grade point
79	average of 3.24, which has led the university's student body
80	statistics for 15 consecutive semesters, and
81	WHEREAS, the collegiate experience continues to enrich the
82	lives of FGCU students through the "FGCU Effect" and the
83	university's longstanding commitment to promoting racial,
84	ethnic, and cultural diversity on campus, NOW, THEREFORE,

86	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of
87	Florida:

89	That March 28, 2017, is recognized as "Florida Gulf Coast
90	University Day" in Florida, and that Florida Gulf Coast
91	University is celebrated for its 20th anniversary as an
92	outstanding institution of higher education focused on student
93	success.
94	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be
95	presented to Wilson G. Bradshaw, Ph.D., president of Florida
96	Gulf Coast University, as a tangible token of the sentiments
97	expressed herein.
