Before December 31, 2017, each physician licensed pursuant to chapter 458 or chapter 459, Florida Statutes, who is registered with the United States Drug Enforcement Agency to prescribe controlled substances pursuant to 21 U.S.C. s. 822 shall complete a 2-hour continuing education course offered by a statewide professional association of physicians in this state which is accredited to



12 provide educational activities designated for the American 13 Medical Association Physician's Recognition Award (AMA PRA) 14 Category 1 Credit or the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) 15 Category 1-A continuing medical education (CME) credit. The 16 course must contain information on the current standards 17 regarding opiate prescribing and alternatives to these standards, and information on the risks of opioid addiction 18 19 following even brief periods of treatment in the management of 2.0 acute pain. The course may be offered in a distance-learning 21 format and must be included within the number of continuing 22 medical education hours required by law.
