(c) The agency determines that conditions exist in the facility which present an imminent danger to the health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the facility or which present a substantial probability that death or serious physical harm would result therefrom. Whenever possible, the agency shall facilitate the continued operation of the program.

34 The licensee cannot meet its financial obligations to (d) 35 provide food, shelter, care, and utilities. Evidence such as the issuance of bad checks or the accumulation of delinquent bills 36 for such items as personnel salaries, food, drugs, or utilities 37 constitutes prima facie evidence that the ownership of the 38 39 facility lacks the financial ability to operate the home in accordance with the requirements of this chapter and all rules 40 promulgated thereunder. 41
