An act relating to warnings for lottery games; amending s. 24.107, F.S.; requiring the Department of the Lottery to provide a specified warning in advertisements or promotions of lottery games; amending s. 24.111, F.S.; requiring contracts entered into between the department and a vendor of lottery tickets to include a provision that requires the vendor to place or print a specified warning on all lottery tickets; specifying requirements for specified warning; amending s. 24.112, F.S.; requiring contracts entered into between the department and a retailer of lottery tickets to include a provision that requires the retailer to prominently display a sign, provided by the department, with a specified warning at the point of sale; providing an effective date.
