Five percent shall be distributed to the Florida 30 Caribbean Charitable Foundation, Inc., to be used only for 31 marketing of the Sun Sea Smiles license plate. 32 2. An additional 30 percent shall be distributed to the Florida Caribbean Charitable Foundation, Inc. Of this amount, up 33 34 to 5 percent may be used for administrative expenses, and the 35 remainder shall be used as follows: 36 a. Sixty percent shall be used for a college scholarship 37 program within this state. b. Fifteen percent shall be used to promote health and 38 39 wellness for residents in this state who are of Caribbean 40 descent. 41 c. Twenty-five percent shall be used to promote awareness 42 of Caribbean culture within this state. 43 3. Fifteen percent shall be distributed to Haitian 44 Neighborhood Center Sant La, Inc., to be used to promote social 45 and community development within this state.
