## Senate Amendment to Amendment (419998) (with title amendment)

Between lines 327 and 328 insert:

Section 11. Section 316.87, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.87 Nonemergency medical transportation services.-

(1) To ensure the availability of nonemergency medical transportation services throughout the state, a provider

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licensed by the county or operating under a permit issued by the county may not be required to use a vehicle that is larger than needed to transport the number of persons being transported or that is inconsistent with the medical condition of the individuals receiving the nonemergency medical transportation services. This section does not apply to the procurement, contracting, or provision of paratransit transportation services, directly or indirectly, by a county or an authority, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended.

- (2) (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Medicaid nonemergency medical transportation services may be provided to a Medicaid beneficiary by a transportation network company. A Medicaid beneficiary shall have the option to use the transportation network company in the fulfillment of the beneficiary's Medicaid nonemergency transportation benefit, unless a licensed medical professional determines that use of a transportation network company to fulfill such benefit would be contrary to a beneficiary's health and safety.
- (b) In providing such Medicaid nonemergency transportation services, transportation network companies shall be governed by s. 627.748.
- (c) This subsection may not be construed to expand or limit the existing transportation benefit provided to Medicaid beneficiaries.
