- 1. Does not provide human remains to another facility.
- 2. Contracts with a funeral director licensed under chapter 497 for the disposal and transportation of the human remains.
- 3. Promotes its anatomical gift program only in hospitals, nursing homes, or hospice programs that are wholly owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by the same parent company that owns the nonprofit surgical training center.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
