316.87 Nonemergency medical transportation services.-

(1) To ensure the availability of nonemergency medical

This section does not apply to the procurement, 17 contracting, or provision of paratransit transportation services, directly or indirectly, by a county or an authority, 18 19 pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as 20 amended.

21 (2) (a) Subject to state and federal Medicaid requirements, 22 Medicaid nonemergency transportation services may be provided to 23 a Medicaid beneficiary by a transportation network company 24 selected by a Medicaid managed care plan, a transportation 25 broker under contract with a Medicaid managed care plan, or a 26 transportation broker under direct contract with the Agency for Health Care Administration. The Agency for Health Care 27 28 Administration shall update the Non-Emergency Transportation 29 Services Coverage Policy pursuant this subsection by October 1, 30 2018. Requirements for transportation network companies and 31 transportation network company drivers shall not exceed the 32 provisions of s. 627.748, except as necessary to conform to 33 federal Medicaid transportation requirements administered by the 34 Agency for Health Care Administration. 35

(b) This subsection may not be construed to expand or limit the existing transportation benefit provided to Medicaid beneficiaries, or to create a right for any transportation network company to enter into a contract with a Medicaid managed 39 care plan or transportation broker.
