11 property or grounds of a jail, prison, or other place where

12 prisoners are confined or in or on the property or grounds of  
13 any court. The term "solicitation" includes the distribution of  
14 business cards, print advertising, or other written or oral  
15 information directed to prisoners or potential indemnitors,  
16 unless a request is initiated by the prisoner or a potential  
17 indemnitor. Permissible print advertising in the jail is  
18 strictly limited to a listing in a telephone directory, ~~and~~ the  
19 posting of the bail bond agent's or agency's name, address, and  
20 telephone number, or uniform advertisements for licensed bail  
21 bond agents approved by the jail administration in a designated  
22 locations ~~location~~ within the jail.
