A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Florida False Claims Act; amending s. 68.084, F.S.; authorizing the Attorney General, on behalf of the Department of Legal Affairs, to voluntarily dismiss certain civil actions; providing an exception; providing that the department may not dismiss such actions on behalf of the state at a later date under certain circumstances; amending s. 68.087, F.S.; deleting a provision prohibiting a court from having jurisdiction over an action brought by an employee or former employee of state government; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) and subsection (3) of section 68.084, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 68.084 Rights of the parties in civil actions.—
- (2) (a) The department, or the Attorney General, as head of the department, may at any point voluntarily dismiss the action notwithstanding the objections of the person initiating the action, unless the department elected not to proceed with the action and the person who initiated the action proceeds with the action under subsection (3).
- (3) If the department elects not to proceed with the action, the person who initiated the action has the right to conduct the action. If the Attorney General, as head of the department, or the Chief Financial Officer, as head of the Department of Financial Services, so requests, it shall be

served with copies of all pleadings and motions filed in the action along with copies of all deposition transcripts at the requesting department's expense. When a person proceeds with the action, the court, without limiting the rights of the person initiating the action, may nevertheless permit the department to intervene and take over the action, except to dismiss the action, on behalf of the state at a later date upon showing of good cause.

Section 2. Subsection (4) of section 68.087, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 68.087 Exemptions to civil actions.
- (4) No court shall have jurisdiction over an action where the person bringing the action under s. 68.083(2) is:
  - (a) acting as an attorney for state government; or
- (b) An employee or former employee of state government, and the action is based, in whole or in part, upon information obtained in the course or scope of government employment.
  - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
