identify and report suspected human trafficking activity. The
operator of a public food service or lodging establishment may
also adopt its own educational program for this purpose, which
must be submitted to the division for approval. The division
must approve such a program if it is determined to be as
comprehensive and effective as similar programs approved by the
division. The division shall adopt rules requiring the operator
of each public food service or lodging establishment to train
any employee reasonably expected to routinely interact with
guests, within a reasonable period of time after hiring, and at
appropriate intervals thereafter, and to maintain documentation
of such training for inspection. The division shall impose
administrative sanctions pursuant to s. 509.261 against an
operator who fails to comply with the rule.

- (2) Upon request, public food service and lodging establishments must provide the division with proof of employee training as required herein, including at the time of a division inspection of the establishment. Proof of training shall include the name, date of birth, and job title of the trained employee; the date the training occurred; and the approved educational program used in training.
