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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to developmental disabilities; providing a short title; amending s. 393.063, F.S.; revising the term "developmental disability" to include the disorder and symptoms attributable to Duchenne muscular dystrophy; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. This act shall be known as "Gabe's Act."

Section 2. Subsection (12) of section 393.063, Florida

Statutes, is amended to read:

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393.063 Definitions.—For the purposes of this chapter, the term:

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(12) "Developmental disability" means a disorder or syndrome that is attributable to intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, autism, spina bifida, Down syndrome, Phelan-McDermid syndrome, or Prader-Willi syndrome, or Duchenne muscular dystrophy; that manifests before the age of 18; and that constitutes a substantial handicap that can reasonably be expected to continue indefinitely.

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Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
