

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to law enforcement activities for
 3 opioids in small counties; creating s. 938.075, F.S.;
 4 requiring a fee to be collected on the deposit of bail
 5 in certain drug and alcohol-related offenses;
 6 providing for deposit of funds; requiring the
 7 Department of Law Enforcement to use such funds for
 8 grants to law enforcement agencies in certain small
 9 counties for drug enforcement activities; providing an
 10 effective date.

 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 14 Section 1. Section 938.075, Florida Statutes, is created
 15 to read:

16 938.075 Bail surcharge in drug and alcohol cases; use by
 17 small counties.-

18 (1) A fee of \$10 is imposed on the grant of bail to a
 19 defendant charged with a violation of s. 316.193, s. 327.35, s.
 20 856.011, s. 856.015, or chapter 893. The fee shall be collected
 21 by the clerk of court at the time bail is posted under chapter
 22 903. The proceeds of the fee shall be deposited in the
 23 Department of Law Enforcement Operating Trust Fund for the
 24 purposes specified in this section.

25 (2) The Department of Law Enforcement shall use the funds

26 | collected under this section to provide grants to law
27 | enforcement agencies in counties with a population of 50,000 or
28 | fewer unincarcerated persons to fund drug enforcement and
29 | related activities of those agencies in those counties. Such
30 | activities may include, but are not limited to, the salaries of
31 | investigators, the purchase of equipment and supplies, and
32 | training for law enforcement personnel and fire rescue personnel
33 | who are responsible for rendering aid to persons victimized by
34 | illegal drug trafficking and manufacturing and the clean-up of
35 | sites where illegal drugs are manufactured.

36 | Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
