Senate Comm: WD 01/25/2018 House

The Committee on Regulated Industries (Steube) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Delete lines 66 - 114
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and insert:

authorized only on private property <u>owned or leased by the</u> <u>distillery which is</u> contiguous to the licensed distillery premises <u>and at one other approved sales room located in the</u> <u>same county as the distillery's production building, which shall</u> <u>be considered an extension of the craft distillery's licensed</u> premises <u>in this state</u> and included on the sketch or diagram

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11 defining the licensed premises submitted with the distillery's 12 license application. All sketch or diagram revisions by the 13 distillery shall require local zoning approval and the 14 division's approval verifying that the souvenir gift shop 15 location and all areas used and operated by the licensed 16 distillery are is owned or leased by the distillery and on property contiguous to the distillery's production building in 17 18 this state or within the extended licensed premises.

A craft distillery may not sell any factory-sealed
individual containers of spirits except in face-to-face sales
transactions <u>at the distillery's licensed premises</u> with
consumers who are making a purchase of no more than six
individual containers of each branded product.

2. Each container sold in face-to-face transactions with consumers must comply with the container limits in s. 565.10, per calendar year for the consumer's personal use and not for resale and who are present at the distillery's licensed premises in this state.

3. A craft distillery must report to the division within 5 days after it reaches the production limitations provided in paragraph (1)(b). Any retail sales to consumers at the craft distillery's licensed premises are prohibited beginning the day after it reaches the production limitation.

4. A craft distillery may not ship or arrange to ship any of its distilled spirits to consumers and may sell and deliver only to consumers within the state in a face-to-face transaction at the distillery property. However, a craft distiller licensed under this section may ship, arrange to ship, or deliver such spirits to manufacturers of distilled spirits, wholesale

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40 distributors of distilled spirits, state or federal bonded 41 warehouses, and exporters.

5. Except as provided in subparagraph 6., it is unlawful to 42 43 transfer a distillery license for a distillery that produces 250,000 75,000 or fewer gallons per calendar year of distilled 44 45 spirits on its premises or any ownership interest in such license to an individual or entity that has a direct or indirect 46 47 ownership interest in any distillery licensed in this state; another state, territory, or country; or by the United States 48 49 government to manufacture, blend, or rectify distilled spirits 50 for beverage purposes.

6. A craft distillery shall not have its ownership affiliated with another distillery, unless such distillery produces <u>250,000</u> <del>75,000</del> or fewer gallons per calendar year of distilled spirits on each of its premises in this state or in another state, territory, or country.

7. A craft distillery may transfer up to 75,000 gallons per calendar year of distilled spirits it manufactures from its federal bonded space, nonbonded space at its licensed premises, or storage areas to its souvenir gift shop and additional sales room.

8. A craft distillery may include a sales room location authorized by this subsection on its original license application or by an amendment to its license application on forms prescribed by the division.
