than 16 years of age commits a noncriminal violation if charged with committing lewd or lascivious battery. The person must sign and accept a citation indicating a promise to appear before the juvenile court. The person must satisfy any penalty within 30 days after receipt of the citation.

2. A person who fails to comply with the citation waives his or her right to contest it and may be charged with a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
