324.252 Motor vehicle insurance online verification system.—

- (1) The department shall establish an online verification system for motor vehicle insurance, subject to the following:
- (a) The verification system shall be accessible through the Internet by authorized personnel of the department, the courts, law enforcement personnel, any other entities authorized by the department, and insurers authorized by the Office of Insurance Regulation to offer motor vehicle insurance.
- (b) The verification system shall provide for direct access to insurers' records by personnel authorized by the department.
- (c) The department shall conduct a pilot program to test the system before statewide use. However, the verification system must be installed and operational by July 1, 2021.
- (d) The verification system shall be available 24 hours a day to verify the insurance status of any vehicle registered in this state through the vehicle's identification number, policy number, registered owner's name, or other identifying characteristic or marker as prescribed by the department.
- (e) The department may contract with a private vendor to assist in establishing and maintaining the verification system.
- (f) The verification system shall include appropriate provisions, consistent with industry standards, to secure its

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data against unauthorized access and to maintain a record of all information requests. A historical record of the system data must be retained by insurers for 5 years after the policy termination date.

- (g) A law enforcement officer, during a traffic stop or crash investigation, shall access information from the online verification system to establish compliance with this chapter and to verify the current validity of the policy described on any insurance identification card produced by the operator of a motor vehicle during the traffic stop or crash investigation.
- (h) The verification system must include a disaster recovery plan designed to ensure service continuity in the event of a disaster.
- (i) The verification system must include information that enables the department to make inquiries of evidence of insurance by using multiple data elements for greater matching accuracy, specifically: insurer National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) company code, Vehicle Identification Number, policy number, level and type of coverage, or other data elements as established by the department.
- (j) An insurance company authorized to issue motor vehicle insurance policies in this state must comply with the verification requirements of motor vehicle insurance for every motor vehicle insured by that company in this state as required

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76 by department rule.

- (k) This section does not apply to vehicles insured under commercial motor vehicle coverage. However, insurers of such vehicles may participate on a voluntary basis.
- (2) Insurers must cooperate with the department in establishing and maintaining the insurance verification system and must provide access to motor vehicle insurance policy status information.
- (3) The department may adopt rules to implement this section.

(f) Upon implementation of the online verification system in s. 324.252, the online verification shall replace the procedures in this subsection and the department and its authorized agents shall use the verification system unless such system is not online or the required information is not available. In such a case, the department and its authorized agent may accept proof of purchase as provided in this subsection to verify the purchase of the required insurance before processing any application for motor vehicle registration.
