7 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section
8 429.55, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 429.55 Consumer information website.—The Legislature finds
10 that consumers need additional information on the quality of
11 care and service in assisted living facilities in order to
12 select the best facility for themselves or their loved ones.
13 Therefore, the Agency for Health Care Administration shall
14 create content that is easily accessible through the home page
15 of the agency's website either directly or indirectly through
16 links to one or more other established websites of the agency's

17 choosing. The website must be searchable by facility name,
18 license type, city, or zip code. By November 1, 2015, the agency
19 shall include all content in its possession on the website and
20 add content when received from facilities. At a minimum, the
21 content must include:

22 (1) Information on each licensed assisted living facility,
23 including, but not limited to:

24 (a) The name, ~~and~~ address, and phone number of the
25 facility. The facility must report changes electronically to the
26 agency through its online licensing portal. The agency shall
27 post the facility's new address on the consumer information
28 website within 30 days.
