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27	insurance; however, the tenant is strongly advised to obtain
28	renters insurance to cover damage to or loss of personal

30	(3) A failure to provide the notice in subsection (2) does
31	not create a private cause of action and does not nullify any

33	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
