1	A bill to be entitled
2	An act for the relief of Ramiro Companioni, Jr., by
3	the City of Tampa; providing for an appropriation to
4	compensate Mr. Companioni for injuries sustained as a
5	result of the negligence of the City of Tampa;
6	providing a limitation on the payment of fees and
7	costs; extinguishing certain lien interests; providing
8	an effective date.

10	WHEREAS, on November 22, 1996, Ramiro Companioni, Jr., was
11	seriously injured while operating his motorcycle on East
12	Hillsborough Avenue in Tampa, Florida, as a result of a
13	collision with a City of Tampa Water Department truck, and
14	WHEREAS, a lawsuit was filed and in 2004 a final judgment
15	was entered in favor of Mr. Companioni in the amount of
16	\$17,928,800 against the City of Tampa, based on a jury verdict
17	in the amount of \$19,932,000, and
18	WHEREAS, after appeals and all legal remedies were
19	exhausted, claim bills have been filed annually since the 2014
20	Legislative session seeking the full amount of the final
21	judgment, plus interest, for Mr. Companioni, and
22	WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to a compromised
23	settlement in the amount of \$5 million, NOW, THEREFORE,

27	Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act
28	are found and declared to be true.
29	Section 2. The City of Tampa is authorized and directed to
30	appropriate from funds not otherwise encumbered and to draw a
31	warrant in the sum of \$5 million, to fund a settlement
32	preservation trust created for the exclusive use and benefit of
33	Ramiro Companioni, Jr., as compensation for injuries and damages
34	sustained as described herein.
35	Section 3. The amount paid by the City of Tampa pursuant
36	to s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, and the amount awarded under
37	this act are intended to provide the sole compensation for all
38	present and future claims arising out of the factual situation
39	described in this act which resulted in injuries and damages to
40	Mr. Companioni. Of the amount awarded under this act, the total
41	amount paid for attorney fees may not exceed \$850,000, the total
42	amount paid for lobbying fees may not exceed \$400,000, and the
43	total amount paid for costs and other similar expenses relating
44	to this claim may not exceed \$7,204.25.
45	Section 4. Excluding the federal portions of any liens,
46	Medicaid or otherwise, which the claimant must pay, it is the
47	intent of the Legislature that the lien interests relating to
48	the treatment and care of Ramiro Companioni, Jr., are hereby
49	waived or extinguished.
50	Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
