8 participate at the public school to which the student would be  
 9 assigned according to district school board attendance area  
 10 policies or which the student could choose to attend pursuant to  
 11 s. 1002.31, or may develop an agreement to participate at a  
 12 private school, in the interscholastic extracurricular  
 13 activities of that school, provided the following conditions are  
 14 met:

- 15 1. The home education student must meet the requirements  
 16 of the home education program pursuant to s. 1002.41.

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17           2. During the period of participation at a school, the  
18 home education student must demonstrate educational progress as  
19 required in paragraph (b) in all subjects taken in the home  
20 education program by a method of evaluation agreed upon by the  
21 parent and the school principal which may include: review of the  
22 student's work by a certified teacher chosen by the parent;  
23 grades earned through correspondence; grades earned in courses  
24 taken at a Florida College System institution, university, or  
25 trade school; standardized test scores above the 35th  
26 percentile; or any other method designated in s. 1002.41.

27           3. The home education student must meet the same residency  
28 requirements as other students in the school at which he or she  
29 participates.

30           4. The home education student must meet the same standards  
31 of acceptance, behavior, and performance as required of other  
32 students in extracurricular activities.

33           5. The student must register with the school his or her  
34 intent to participate in interscholastic extracurricular  
35 activities as a representative of the school before  
36 participation ~~the beginning date of the season for the activity~~  
37 ~~in which he or she wishes to participate~~. A home education  
38 student must be able to participate in curricular activities if  
39 that is a requirement for an extracurricular activity.

40           6. A student who transfers from a home education program  
41 to a public school before or during the first grading period of

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42 | the school year is academically eligible to participate in  
43 | interscholastic extracurricular activities during the first  
44 | grading period provided the student has a successful evaluation  
45 | from the previous school year, pursuant to subparagraph 2.

46 |         7. Any public school or private school student who has  
47 | been unable to maintain academic eligibility for participation  
48 | in interscholastic extracurricular activities is ineligible to  
49 | participate in such activities as a home education student until  
50 | the student has successfully completed one grading period in  
51 | home education pursuant to subparagraph 2. to become eligible to  
52 | participate as a home education student.
