House Resolution

A resolution designating April 1-7, 2018, as "Autism Awareness Week" in Florida.

WHEREAS, autism spectrum disorder is a lifelong developmental disability resulting in the impairment of an individual's ability to learn, develop healthy interactive behaviors, and understand verbal, nonverbal, and reciprocal communication, and

WHEREAS, autism is the result of a neurological disorder affecting brain function, and although it affects millions nationwide, including one in every 68 children, few understand this complex disorder, and

WHEREAS, children with autism have a variety of symptoms and disabilities, and

WHEREAS, children with autism have been excluded from participation in sports and extracurricular activities because of their symptoms and disabilities, and

WHEREAS, participation in athletic training helps refine motor skills, improve communication, teach sportsmanship, increase social interactions, develop behavior management, boost self-esteem, and promote physical fitness, and

WHEREAS, research continues with the goal of understanding and finding treatment options to help those affected by this complex neurological disorder and efforts continue to provide
