## Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 15-54 and insert:

- (a) A person depicted in a sexually explicit image taken with the person's consent <u>may retain</u> has a reasonable expectation that the image will remain private <u>despite sharing</u> the image with another person, such as an intimate partner.
- (b) It is becoming a common practice for persons to publish a sexually explicit image of another to Internet websites or to disseminate such an image through electronic means without the depicted person's consent, contrary to the depicted person's reasonable expectation of privacy, for no

legitimate purpose, with the intent of causing substantial emotional distress to the depicted person.

- (c) When such images are published on Internet websites, the images they are able to be viewed indefinitely by persons worldwide and are able to be easily reproduced and shared.
- (d) The publication <u>or dissemination</u> of such images <u>through the use of <del>on</del> on the sites or electronic means</u> creates a permanent record of the depicted person's private nudity or private sexually explicit conduct.
- (e) The existence of such images on Internet websites or the dissemination of such images without the consent of all parties depicted in the images causes those depicted in such images significant psychological harm.
- (f) Safeguarding the psychological well-being <u>and privacy</u> <u>interests</u> of persons depicted in such images is compelling.
  - (2) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "Image" includes, but is not limited to, any photograph, picture, motion picture, film, video, or representation.
- (b) "Personal identification information" means any information that identifies an individual, and includes, but is not limited to, any name, postal or electronic mail address, telephone number, social security number, date of birth, or any unique physical representation has the same meaning as provided in s. 817.568.

website or disseminate through electronic means to another person a sexually explicit image of a person that contains or conveys the personal identification information of the depicted person to an Internet website without the depicted person's consent, contrary to the depicted person's reasonable expectation that the image would remain private, for no legitimate purpose, with the intent of causing substantial emotional distress to the depicted person. Evidence that the depicted person sent a sexually explicit image to another person does not, on its own, remove his or her reasonable expectation of privacy for that image.
