10	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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12	Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 465.019, Florida
13	Statutes, is amended to read:
14	465.019 Institutional pharmacies; permits
15	(4) Medicinal drugs shall be dispensed in an institutional
16	pharmacy to outpatients only when that institution has secured a
17	community pharmacy permit from the department. However, an
18	individual licensed to prescribe medicinal drugs in this state
19	may dispense up to a <u>48-hour</u> 24-hour supply of a medicinal drug
20	to any patient of, or patient discharged from, an emergency
21	department of a hospital that operates a Class II or Class III
22	institutional pharmacy, provided that the physician treating the
23	patient in such hospital's emergency department <u>or the</u>
24	discharged patient determines that the medicinal drug is
25	warranted and that community pharmacy services are not readily
26	accessible, geographically or otherwise, to the patient. Such
27	dispensing from the emergency department to any patient,
28	including a discharged patient, must be in accordance with the
29	procedures of the hospital. For any such patient for whom a

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30	medicinal drug is warranted for a period to exceed $\underline{48}$ $\underline{24}$ hours,
31	an individual licensed to prescribe such drug must dispense a
32	<u>48-hour</u> 24-hour supply of such drug to the patient and must
33	provide the patient with a prescription for such drug for use
34	after the initial $\underline{48}$ -hour $\underline{24}$ -hour period. The board may adopt
35	rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this subsection.
36	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.

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
