## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Delete lines 22 - 38

and insert:

Section 1. Section 163.3214, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

163.3214 Tree pruning, trimming, or removal on singlefamily residential property.-

- (1) A local government may not require a permit, an application, the provision of a notice, a fee, or impose a fine:
  - (a) For the pruning, trimming, or removal of a tree on a

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single-family residential property if the property owner has obtained documentation from an arborist certified by the International Society of Arboriculture or a Florida licensed landscape architect that the tree is a danger to persons or property and the tree is not a specimen, heritage, or patriarch tree, as defined by local ordinances or regulations.

- (b) For the pruning or trimming of a specimen, heritage, or patriarch tree, as defined by local ordinances or regulations, on a single-family residential property if the property owner has obtained documentation from an arborist certified by the International Society of Arboriculture or a Florida licensed landscape architect that the tree is a danger to persons or property.
- (2) A local government may enforce ordinances or regulations pertaining to the replacement of trees that have been removed in accordance with this section. However a local ordinance or regulation may not require the single-family residential property owner to replace more than one tree for each tree removed.
- (3) This section does not apply to the exercise of specifically delegated authority for mangrove protection pursuant to ss. 403.9321-403.9333 or to trees listed as endangered species.
