- (a) The supervisor shall enter into an agreement with the local clerk of the circuit court to receive monthly from such clerk change-of-address information and a list of potential jurors who identified themselves as aliens, as defined in s. 327.02(2), during the preceding calendar month. Each list shall include the name, address, date of birth, sex, and, whichever is available, the Florida driver license number or Florida identification card number of each such person. Each month the supervisor shall compare all of the information included in the list with the statewide voter registration system.
- Section 2. Paragraph (h) is added to subsection (2) of section 98.093, Florida Statutes, to read:
- 98.093 Duty of officials to furnish information relating to deceased persons, persons adjudicated mentally incapacitated, and persons convicted of a felony, and persons identified as aliens.—
- (2) To the maximum extent feasible, state and local government agencies shall facilitate provision of information and access to data to the department, including, but not limited to, databases that contain reliable criminal records and records of deceased persons. State and local government agencies that provide such data shall do so without charge if the direct cost incurred by those agencies is not significant.
- (h) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall furnish monthly to the department a list of persons who

identified themselves as aliens, as defined in s. 327.02(2), during the preceding calendar month. Each list shall include the name, address, date of birth, sex, and, whichever is available, the Florida driver license number or Florida identification card number of each such person. Each month the department shall compare all of the information included in the list with the statewide voter registration system and if the department determines that a registered voter is an alien, provide the name of such voter to the supervisor of elections of the county in which the voter is registered.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
