Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (5) of section 1001.42, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1001.42 Powers and duties of district school board.-The district school board, acting as a board, shall exercise all powers and perform all duties listed below:

- (5) PERSONNEL.-
- (b) Immediately investigate any legally sufficient



complaint that involves misconduct by an educational support employee as defined in s. 1012.40(1)(a) or a substitute teacher employed pursuant to s. 1012.35 which affects the health, safety, or welfare of a student and would otherwise result in termination. An investigation that results in termination must be reported to the department for placement on the disqualification list. The commissioner may withhold certain funding from any school district or charter school that fails to report any legally sufficient complaint that involves misconduct by an employee or contracted personnel which affects the health, safety, or welfare of a student.

(c) Notwithstanding s. 1012.55 or any other provision of law or rule to the contrary and consistent with adopted district school board policy relating to alternative certification for school principals, have the authority to appoint persons to the position of school principal who do not hold educator certification.
