Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Section 482.242</u>, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, <u>is repealed</u>. Section 2. Section 482.244, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

482.244 Local ordinances, special laws, and local regulations.—A county, municipality, or other local political subdivision may not adopt or enforce any local ordinance, special law, or local regulation governing pest control which is less stringent than general law or agency rule.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
