I of the State 19 20 Constitution, except that a surviving spouse of the decedent may view and copy any such photograph or video recording or listen 21 22 to or copy any such audio recording. If there is no surviving 23 spouse, then the surviving parents shall have access to such 24 records. If there is no surviving spouse or parent, the then an 25 adult children child shall have access to such records.
