4 Between lines 126 and 127, insert:

5 (n) A funding provision that delineates costs incurred by
6 each entity.

7 1. School districts shall pay public postsecondary
8 institutions the standard tuition rate per credit hour from
9 funds provided in the Florida Education Finance Program when
10 dual enrollment course instruction takes place on the
11 postsecondary institution's campus and the course is taken
12 during the fall or spring term. When dual enrollment is provided
13 on the high school site by postsecondary institution faculty,

14 the school district shall reimburse the costs associated with
15 the postsecondary institution's proportion of salary and
16 benefits to provide the instruction. When dual enrollment course
17 instruction is provided on the high school site by school
18 district faculty, the school district is not responsible for
19 payment to the postsecondary institution. A postsecondary
20 institution may enter into an agreement with the school district
21 to authorize teachers to teach dual enrollment courses at the
22 high school site or the postsecondary institution. A school
23 district may not deny a student access to dual enrollment unless
24 the student is ineligible to participate in the program subject
25 to provisions specifically outlined in this section.

26 2. Subject to annual appropriation in the General
27 Appropriations Act, a public postsecondary institution shall
28 receive an amount of funding equivalent to the standard tuition
29 rate per credit hour for each dual enrollment course taken by a
30 student during the summer term.

31 3. Subject to annual appropriation in the General
32 Appropriations Act, a public postsecondary institution that uses
33 technology to provide dual enrollment courses on the
34 institution's campus or on the high school site and has a total
35 number of dual enrollment students that meets or exceeds 25
36 percent of the institution's total FTE or total headcount
37 enrollment shall receive an appropriation in an amount
38 equivalent to the statewide average cost of a fulltime faculty
