Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Between lines 66 and 67, insert:

(4) District school boards may not refuse to enter into a dual enrollment articulation agreement with a local Florida College System institution if that Florida College System institution has the capacity to offer dual enrollment courses. A district school board or a Florida College System institution may not limit the number of students who enter dual enrollment programs, including early college acceleration programs under s. 1007.273, unless the commissioner grants a request for a 1-year waiver due to capacity to offer a quality program. The waiver must describe the existing capacity issues and specific courses

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16 or programs that cannot be offered and suggest solutions and a
17 timeline for achieving the capacity needed to meet the demand.

18 (15) The Department of Education shall develop a statement
19 on transfer guarantees to inform students and their parents,
20 prior to enrollment in a dual enrollment course, of the
21 potential for the dual enrollment course to articulate as an
22 elective or a general education course into a postsecondary
23 education certificate or degree program. This statement shall
24 include the English and mathematics courses that require a grade
25 of C or higher to measure student achievement in college-level
26 communication and computation skills, pursuant to state board
27 rule. The statement shall be provided to each district school
28 superintendent, who shall include the statement in the
29 information provided to all secondary students and their parents
30 as required pursuant to this subsection. The statement may also
31 include additional information, including, but not limited to,
32 dual enrollment options, guarantees, privileges, and
33 responsibilities.
