5 Remove lines 217-230 and insert:

6 (f) Documentation demonstrating how the program ensures or
 7 does not ensure that:

8 1. Canadian suppliers participating in the program are of
 9 high quality, of high performance, and in full compliance with
 10 relevant Canadian federal and provincial laws and regulations;

11 2. Prescription drugs imported under the program are not
 12 shipped, sold, or dispensed outside of the state once in the
 13 possession of the importer;

14 3. Prescription drugs imported under the program are pure,
 15 unadulterated, potent, and safe;

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16 4. The program does not put consumers at a higher health
17 and safety risk than if the program did not exist;

18 5. The program provides cost savings to the state on
19 imported prescription drugs;

20 6. The program prevents the occurrence of injuries and
21 deaths associated with prescription drugs imported from outside
22 of the United States;

23 7. The purchase of prescription drugs from outside of the
24 United States does not result in lost taxes or revenue for state
25 and federal governments;

26 8. There are regulatory controls over Canadian suppliers
27 that provide substandard or dangerous prescription drugs; and

28 9. There are remedies for individuals participating in the
29 program who are injured or harmed by substandard or dangerous
30 prescription drugs.
