shall solicit the electronic votes of the supervisors of elections on the uniform vote target, and shall require supervisors of elections to immediately implement a vote target that receives at least a two-thirds majority vote. Thereafter, the Secretary of State shall solicit the electronic votes of the supervisors of elections on the uniform vote target when at least 10 percent of the supervisors of elections formally petition for a change in the vote target, and shall require supervisors of elections to immediately implement a vote target that receives a unanimous vote.

(c) Paragraph (b) notwithstanding, a supervisor of elections who must make a substantial change to a voting system in order to comply with this requirement shall implement the uniform vote target as soon as is practicable within 6 years after such vote target is selected.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
