| 26 | (3) School districts are encouraged to provide basic            |
| 27 | training in first aid, including cardiopulmonary resuscitation, |
| 28 | for all students, beginning in grade 6 and every 2 years        |
| 29 | thereafter. Instruction in the use of cardiopulmonary           |
| 30 | resuscitation must be based on a nationally recognized program  |
| 31 | that uses the most current evidence-based emergency             |
| 32 | cardiovascular care guidelines. The instruction must allow      |
| 33 | students to practice the psychomotor skills associated with     |
| 34 | performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation and use an automated   |
| 35 | external defibrillator when a school district has the equipment |
