- Section 1. (1) Effective July 1, 2019, the Legislature shall appropriate funds to grant a one-time competitive pay adjustment of 10 percent to the base rate of pay on June 30, 2019, for employees of the Senate, the House of Representatives, joint legislative offices, the Auditor General, the Commission on Ethics, and the Office of Public Counsel who are in the following job classifications established in the Joint Policies and Procedures of the Presiding Officers of the Legislature:
