well stimulation or matrix acidization; providing

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Present subsections (6) through (10) and (11) through (32) of section 377.19, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (7) through (11) and (13) through (34), respectively, subsection (5) of that section is amended, and new subsections (6) and (12) are added to that section, to read:

377.19 Definitions.—As used in ss. 377.06, 377.07, and 377.10-377.40, the term:

- (5) "Gas" means all natural gas, including casinghead gas, and all other hydrocarbons not defined as oil in subsection (17)  $\frac{(15)}{(15)}$ .
- (6) "High-pressure well stimulation" means all stages of a well intervention performed by injecting fluids into a rock formation at a pressure that equals or exceeds the fracture gradient of the rock formation in order to fracture the

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formation to increase production or recovery from an oil or gas well, such as in hydraulic fracturing or acid fracturing.

intervention performed by injecting fluids into a rock formation at a pressure below the fracture gradient of the rock formation in order to dissolve the formation and increase production or recovery from an oil or gas well. The term does not include techniques used for routine well cleanout work, routine well maintenance, routine treatment for the purpose of removal of formation damage due to drilling or production, or acidizing techniques used to maintain or restore the natural permeability of the formation near the wellbore.

Section 2. Section 377.2405, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 377.2405 Advanced well stimulation treatments.-
- (1) PROHIBITION.—The performance of high-pressure well stimulation or matrix acidization is prohibited in this state. A permit for drilling or operating a well does not authorize the performance of high-pressure well stimulation or matrix acidization.
- (2) APPLICABILITY.—This section applies only to wells regulated pursuant to chapter 377.
  - Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
