15	(12)(a) A license issued under this section does not
16	authorize any person to openly carry a handgun or carry a
17	concealed weapon or firearm into:
18	1. Any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05;
19	2. Any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station;
20	3. Any detention facility, prison, or jail;
21	4. Any courthouse;
22	5. Any courtroom, except that nothing in this section
23	would preclude a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or
24	determining who will carry a concealed weapon in his or her
25	courtroom;
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26	6. Any polling place;
27	7. Any meeting of the governing body of a county, public
28	school district, municipality, or special district;
29	8. Any meeting of the Legislature or a committee thereof;
