Remove lines 32-49 and insert:

(2) (a) Subject to compliance with state and federal
 Medicaid requirements, a transportation network company under
 contract with a Medicaid managed care plan, a transportation
 broker under contract with a Medicaid managed care plan, a
 transportation broker under contract with the Agency for
 Healthcare Administration, or a transportation network company
 that receives referrals from a transportation broker contracted
 with Medicaid managed care plans or the Agency for Healthcare
 Administration may provide nonemergency medical transportation
 services under ss. 409.905 and 409.973 to a Medicaid recipient.

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17 The Agency for Healthcare Administration shall update any
18 regulations, policies, or other guidance, including the Non-
19 Emergency Transportation Services Coverage Policy, as necessary,
20 to reflect this authorization by October 1, 2019. Requirements
21 for transportation network companies and transportation network
22 company drivers may not exceed those imposed under s. 627.748,
23 except as necessary to conform to state and federal Medicaid
24 transportation requirements administered by the Agency for
25 Health Care Administration.

26 (b) This subsection may not be construed to expand or limit
27 the existing transportation benefit provided to Medicaid
28 recipients or to require a Medicaid managed care plan to
29 contract with a transportation network company or transportation
30 broker.
