Section 3. (1) The Legislature finds that an important state interest is served in protecting the public safety by ensuring that 911 telecommunications are routed to the most appropriate 911 system in the most expeditious manner possible. A proper and legitimate state purpose is achieved when local government 911 public safety telecommunicators are able to transfer and receive transfers of emergency calls to and from other local, multijurisdictional, or regional E911 systems in the state.

(2) The Legislature also finds that an important state
interest is served in protecting the public safety by ensuring
that text-to-911 service is available in all counties of the
state. A proper and legitimate state purpose is achieved when
text-to-911 service is made available statewide to ensure that
persons who cannot speak or whose safety may be compromised by
speaking in emergency situations will have access to the 911
system and to avoid confusion about the availability of such
service in particular areas.

(3) Therefore, the Legislature finds and declares that this act fulfills an important state interest.
