30	(a) By July 1, 2020, each court reporter must register with
31	the Supreme Court his or her name, address, phone number, e-mail
32	address, and method of reporting, such as stenography, voice, or
33	digital, and must list each professional credential the reporter
34	holds with the identity of the professional association that
35	issued the credential, for inclusion in the court reporter
36	registry. The Supreme Court shall add the court reporter's

38	submitted a completed registration on a form created by the

40	(b) Each court reporter must update his or her name,
